Purpose: The purpose of this assignment is to distinguish the different roles and responsibilities the American Red Cross has before, during, and after a disaster.

For your Disaster class you will have three (3) American Red Cross on-line modules to complete. These courses are recognized everywhere in the United States and its territories, should you decide to become a Red Cross disaster nurse.

Instructions:

- 1) Create an account in EDGE
 - See accompanying instructions - ARC On-line Modules Instructions
 - When creating an account select the following:
 - Division > Disaster Function
 - Organization Type > Community Partner
 - Regional Name > N/A
- 2) Once you have created an account log onto EDGE and click *Browse for Training* > *Disaster Cycle Services (in the left column)* > *scroll down to find the following modules (select the module with the book icon or computer screen icon):*
 - **Disaster Cycle Services: An Overview**
 - **Health Services Fundamental 1**
 - **Health Services Fundamental 2**
- 3) Launch the course
- 4) After completing the assessment (test) you will be able to print your certificate.

Troubleshooting Tips:

- Check to make sure your pop-up blockers are turned off.
- Check your security settings as it may prevent the course from launching
- Try using a different browser (Firefox is best)
- Some of the courses may not launch for Ipad or tablets
- When accessing the courses, you may need to click on the little green button in the top, left corner to resize the module. This will give you access to the control buttons at the bottom of the module.
